Selectmen Meeting Minutes – April 7, 2014

Opening: The Board of Selectmen meeting was called to order at 6:30PM on April 7, 2014 in Stow by Kathleen Ela.

Present: Kathleen Ela, Richard Meserve, and Susan Smith

Approval of Agenda: The agenda was unanimously approved.

Approval of Minutes: The minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

Town Clerk Business: Chris had the selectmen sign the warrants for SAD Referendum Votes. April 29th is for the Fryeburg Academy Contract and May 6th is the Cost Sharing Referendum for the new School Project.

Open Issues:

New Business:

On March 31st the selectmen had a workshop meeting. The Building Committee from Chatham came to look at the Municipal Office because they are thinking about building one.

The selectmen also met with Sharon Fisher, Karen Bemis, Henry and Sara Neddenriep, Cliff Brown, and Michael Mendonca in reference to the Lovell Rec. Article at Town Meeting. They were unhappy that the vote only gave the Rec Dept. \$1000.00 instead of the requested amount of \$1500.00. The selectmen told them that they would have to file a petition with enough signatures to revisit the Article at a Special Town Meeting.

Today they passed in their petition and Chris has verified enough legal signatures to have the Article revisited.

The selectmen have scheduled a Special Town Meeting on April 19, 2014 with three articles. One to vote on raising of \$1200.00 for the Saco Valley Fire Dept. that was omitted by mistake from the amount on the March 15, 2014 Town Meeting, second is to vote in an alternate Sad 72 Director, and third the reconsideration of Article 34 regarding the amount of money that will be raised and granted for the Lovell Rec Dept.

After the Special Town meeting the selectmen will hold an informational meeting on the New School Project.

There will be post cards mailed to all registered voters to inform them of the Special Town Meeting.

Kathleen Ela will call Kathleen Hathaway regarding her billing as Animal Control Officer. The bill is tardy and has some questionable calls that need to be explained. She will request that she attend the next selectmen's meeting.

Richard talked to Double T Fence Co. about fencing to be able to close and lock the salt shed.

Warrant #7 for \$12,384.52 was approved and signed.

Adjournment: Meeting was adjourned at 7:55PM by Kathleen Ela. The next selectmen's meeting will be at 6:30PM on Monday, April 21, 2014.
