Selectmen Meeting Minutes – March 17, 2014

Opening: The Board of Selectmen meeting was called to order at 6:30PM on March 17, 2014 in Stow by Kathleen Ela.

Present: Kathleen Ela, Richard Meserve, Susan Smith, and Olin Lusky

Approval of Agenda: The agenda was unanimously approved.

Approval of Minutes: The minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

Town Clerk Business: Chris wanted a list of all the Town Roads that are posted. The list includes Meadow Rd, Chatham Rd, Union Hill Rd, Lake Rd, & South Chatham Rd.

Chris notified the board that Jim Wilfong might not be able to be the Sad 72 Alternate Director for the Town of Stow because his wife is a teacher in SAD 72. Jim had talked to Chris and said he would be on the Board of Appeals.

Open Issues: On Sunday, day after Town Meeting, Meg Dyer, Lovell Recreation Director, emailed Susan the breakdown for children from Stow participating in their programs. Last year there were 10 families and a total of 19 children enrolled.

New Business: Kathleen Ela was voted in as Head Selectmen for the ensuing year.

Olin Lusky was in to discuss his concerns that the Town should have an assistant or deputy Town Clerk. The selectmen acknowledged his concern but they have tried this before and no one wants to take all the classes and learn the job for such a limited amount of hours.

Steve Goldsmith called Richard and said the Town of Lovell bought new dump containers with covers so snow and rain won't be in with the trash.

Warrant #5 for \$50,092.85 was approved and signed.
