Selectmen Meeting Minutes – April 20, 2015

Opening: The Board of Selectmen meeting was called to order at 6:30PM on April 20, 2015 in Stow by Richard Meserve.

Present: Richard Meserve, Susan Smith, and Kathleen Ela,

Approval of Agenda: The agenda was unanimously approved.

Approval of Minutes: The minutes of the previous meeting were unanimously approved.

Town Clerk Business: The clerk reported to Board of Selectmen that there was an altercation between Lawrence Perry and Eben Bemis regarding the hunting dogs and the Animal Control Officer had to be called and the Sheriff. Lawrence has not applied for a kennel license in Stow for his dogs. If he is living here he must get his license here and if he has a kennel license in Fryeburg he must house them there. Selectmen will address this issue.

Open Issues: After the letters were sent out to all property owners with liens on 2013 taxes requesting names and addresses for any lien holders on their property, there are 10 that have not responded. Selectmen decided to authorize title searches on three properties and the cost will be added to the property owner's fees on liens as was stated in letter.

New Business: Selectmen have revised the three year Snow Contract and will put a notice in paper on May 1st with deadline of August 1st for anyone interested in submitting bids. A copy of the Snow Contract is available at the Town Office.

Steve Stewart from Khiel's is getting together prices for quarry crushed gravel for finishing Union Hill Project, section south of Meadow Rd. Also he is pricing for doing section north of Meadow Rd.

Selectmen viewed and initialed reconciled bank statements.

The second May selectmen's meeting will be held on Tuesday, May 19th because Diana is not available for Monday, May 18th.

Warrant #8 for \$41,154.71 was approved and signed.
