Selectmen Meeting Minutes – June 20, 2016

Opening: The Board of Selectmen meeting was called to order at 6:00PM on June 20, 2016 in Stow by Richard Meserve.

Approval of Agenda: The agenda was unanimously approved.

Approval of Minutes: The minutes of the previous meeting were unanimously approved.

Town Clerk Business: Chris will send 30 day notices for 2015 unpaid taxes.

Open Issues: Easements on Lake Rd for drainage and ditches have been received and recorded at the Registry of Deeds.

Diana went to Registry of Deeds and got a credit for a payment we made with lien releases.

Loan for \$40,000.00 to purchase land for New Sand & Salt Shed from Androscoggin Bank is scheduled for closing on June 30th. We received copies of paperwork and the board approved and gave Richard, Diana, and Chris authority to sign all paperwork.

The order that came in for road work safety items was missing one sign. Also ordered two types of barricades.

Susan discovered we can resubmit an application for a grant for culvert on Lake Rd. We should repair what we have for now and then resubmit for a replacement culvert.

New Business: There will be a public meeting on July 6, 2016 at 6:00PM about the Ranhoff appeal. Will also discuss Town of Stow, Maine Land-use Ordinance and Street Acceptance Ordinance.

Richard filled out questionnaire for Road Block Grant.

The selectmen approved completing the last section of the Union Hill Project.

DOT is willing to participate in the New Sand and Salt Project.

The reconciled bank statements for May were viewed and initialed.

Warrant #12 for \$82,863.65 was approved and signed.
