

# Town of Stow

Selectmen Meeting Minutes – May 6, 2013

**Opening:** The Board of Selectmen meeting was called to order at 6:30PM on May 6, 2013 in Stow by Kathleen Ela

**Present:** Kathleen Ela, Richard Meserve, Susan Smith, and William Ela

**Approval of Agenda:** The agenda was unanimously approved.

**Approval of Minutes:** The minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

**Open Issues:** Bill Bailey told Chris he was not interested in being the assistant dog control officer.

**New Business:** Richard and Kathleen went to Stoneham for a General Assistance training program. Gerard Biron was the instructor and it lasted for four hours.

Selectmen received a complaint from Summit Achievement regarding their road. The complaint was dated April 19<sup>th</sup> and William Ela raked it on April 28<sup>th</sup>.

A notice came for TD Bank that our CD was to rollover in May. The selectmen agreed to let it roll over.

John Plowden said the Town of Fryeburg will no longer license the Saco Valley Fire Department's fire trucks as municipal vehicles because they are a separate fire dept. from Fryeburg's.

Selectmen voted (3-0) to have Clyde Watson replace two culverts on Lake Rd. Richard will call him.

Clyde has said maybe he could ditch Union Hill Rd. in July. Richard needs to talk to land owner about ditch on their property.

Road bands were lifted as of May 1<sup>st</sup>.

Selectmen agreed to allow \$10,000 of the Roads and Bridges money to be spent on the Union Hill Project, building up the road for future tarring. All money spent on the Union Hill Rd. will be separated in a sub category of the Roads & Bridges account so that it can be easily be tracked.

The selectmen received a package from Joel Gray's lawyer concerning their research on the Wiley Road status and the selectmen were asked to make a decision based on their findings.

The selectmen unanimously agreed and made the following statement: Based on the information given to us from Joel Gray's attorney, we don't feel we have enough information or have the qualification to make a decision as to whether the road was discontinued or abandon. This will need to be settled between the landowners who are involved.

Henry Neddenriep came in on Sarah's behalf. The selectmen asked him to let her know they had voted to pay \$125.00 from the 2012 balance forward amount of the Conservation Committee's budget to be paid to her for the grocery slip for the 2012 clean up cookout. Please have her respond to the selectmen so that they can authorize a check to be written.

Warrant #10 for \$3,215.87 was approved & signed.
