Opening: The Board of Selectmen meeting was called to order at 6:30PM on July 7, 2014 in Stow by Kathleen Ela.

Approval of Agenda: The agenda was unanimously approved.

Approval of Minutes: The minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

Town Clerk Business: All TAN documents were reviewed, signed, and sealed with the Town seal. They will be returned to Bernstein Shur, bond counsel, and then will be sent to TD Bank for funding on July 25th.

Open Issues: There has been an agreement made with the Wolf Refuge. They will transport their unusable food rubbish to Lewiston and will be charged directly.

Bruce Manzi has the gravel screened and ready to start the Union Hill Project. He expects to start next month.

New Business: The Town received a grant for \$10,000.00 from Marshall L. and Ruth Anne Gibson to be divided equally between Fuel for Neighbors and Elderly Tax Relief.

Susan went to a School Reapportionment meeting for votes received per Town. Fryeburg still has 6 votes but are not weighted as heavily and Brownfield has 2 votes but can be weighted to 3.

The reconciled bank statements were reviewed and initialed.

Warrant #16 for \$65,052.07 was approved and signed.
