Selectmen Meeting Minutes – May 9, 2011

Opening: The Board of Selectmen meeting was called to order at 6:30PM on May 9, 2011 in Stow by Roger Kiesman, Chairman.

Approval of Agenda: The agenda was unanimously approved.

Approval of Minutes: The minutes of the previous meeting were unanimously approved.

Open Issues: On Wednesday, Michael & Carla from Alpineweb Design will do a conference call with Aaron Johnson to get domain name turned over to the Town. Selectmen gave approval for Carla to create a new website for the Town.

Christine got prices from Computer Port for the new computer system & presented to the board. It was unanimously approved. She will notify them to start building the system.

Michael met with a representative of MMA's Property & Casualty. He found a few issues to be attended to by the selectmen. Outside wall should be cleaned from exhaust fan. Furnace servicing should be dated by furnace. A couple of wall outlets need attention due to lightning damage. There is a soffit in the all purpose room that needs fixing.

New Business:

Bill Perry, selectman from Chatham, will schedule meeting with Lovell selectmen to finish contract details for use of Lovell transfer station. Michael will attend & represent the Stow board of selectmen.

John Plowden, fire chief of Saco Valley Fire Dept., came to update selectmen about changes they are making. The North Fire Station will be closed due to lack of manpower to use the engine there. They will sell that engine. They will also sell a 1952 army truck. They will return engine #4 to Fryeburg as soon as they can buy a replacement. John is the Town of Stow's Fire Warden & Jeff Blake is Deputy Fire Warden. These are the people to contact for a fire permit.

Reported by Michael Mendonca - The Valley Clean-up Day was a huge success. Thirty or more attended. Henry and Sarah Neddenriep did a nice job. Michael would like to encourage all Town's people that can not attend to clean up the roadside near their own homes.

Warrant#18 for \$719.64 was approved and signed.
